



## Adult Cystic Fibrosis Program Eligibility

The Abilities Inc. of Florida, Adult Cystic Fibrosis Program (ACFP) provides medical case management and CF related services to adults with CF throughout the State of Florida. The Program is administered by the Florida Department of Health (DOH) and is also part of a Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Program that receives federal funding. Eligibility is based on the following:

- State of Florida resident with intent to remain in Florida
- Must have a Florida Driver's License
- Have need for medically necessary services for CF not covered by medical insurance or Medicaid
- Have a monthly income (before taxes) of **\$2022.00** or less
- Have cash assets less than or equal to **\$2000 (if single), \$3,000 (if married).**
- Physician sponsorship (Florida physician)
- Contact case manager monthly

Please submit a copy of the following with your ACFP Application:

- Florida Driver's License
- Medicare, Medicaid or insurance card
- Social Security Card
- SSA letter (if applicable) with monthly SSI/SSDI income
- Current month of pay stubs (if you are working)
- Three months bank statements- (checking and savings) all accounts with your name on them must be submitted
- Assets including any stocks, bonds, Certificates of Deposits (CD's), or life insurance that have a cash value.
- Two-year history of CF inpatient hospitalizations
- Medication list

**To be eligible for Program you must meet current Medicaid financial eligibility standards, as defined by the State of Florida.** Acceptance in to the Program is "first come, first served" based on the date your application is screened for admission.
